### Things to be to keep in mind when attending recovery meetings:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Be on time</b>—<i>you will not receive credit for attendance if late.</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Remain in the meeting for the entire time</b>—<i>you will not receive credit for attendance if you leave before the meeting is over, repeatedly going in and out of the meeting, or stay outside during the meeting for any substantial amount of time</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Do not be a distraction to others</b>—<i>stay off your cell phones, stay seated/do not get up constantly, sit quietly unless asked to speak or contribute to the discussion</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Listen</b>— <i>someone may have a similar story or background that you can identify with and feel comfortable talking to; sponsorship is mandatory and pertinent to the recovery process</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Reach out--</b> <i>share at meetings and/or exchange phone numbers (and call) with active members who can assist you in finding a sponsor; obtain a sponsor with at least 2 years of sobriety and begin working the 12-steps</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Read the books and literature</b>—<i>get help from your sponsor if having difficulty understanding any of the material</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Participate/get involved</b>—<i>remember: the stronger your recovery support system, the better chances of long term sobriety; ways to get involved— talk to and/or meet with your sponsor regularly, get a home group, do service work, develop a list of other active members you can call and participate with in AA/NA/CA activities</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Go to as many meetings as you like</b>—<i>however, please pay close attention to the number of meetings you must attend to obtain credit that appear on the approved listing</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Provide your own outside meeting sheet to the meeting chairperson for signature or stamping</b>—<i>the chairperson’s signature or meeting stamp is required to show proof of attendance</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Do not give your outside meeting sheet to someone else to have signed/stamped by the meeting chairperson if you are not in attendance for the meeting</b>—<i>again, you are the only person that should be providing your sheet at meetings for signature</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Turn in your own outside meeting sheet to your Treatment Provider</b></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Do not sign/stamp a chairperson(s) name on your outside meeting sheet or any others</b>—<i>forgery can result in termination from the program</i></li> </ul>

### Some Common Meeting Descriptions of Recovery Meetings

**Open meetings** – are open to anyone, including family or friends; anyone who is interested in learning more about the program of recovery.

**Closed meetings**— are not open to everyone; only those identifying themselves as “having a desire to stop using” may attend; members can speak openly and honestly about their problem or situation, knowing that everyone else in the room has experienced similar situations.

**Big Book or “Step Meetings”** where specific literature from the *Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions* or *Alcoholics Anonymous* (the Big Book) are read and discussed.

**Speaker meetings**-- where one individual talks, sharing the story of his or her recovery.

**Discussion meetings**-- where everyone shares, talking about a topic or whatever is on his or her mind.
